The physicals are done in August each year.

Parents are asked to make a donation to the school for the physicals, but no student is turned away if they're unable

to pay. The Athletic Directors will tell you that it is one of the biggest fundraisers for the schools and that Dr. Teasdale

is one of the most accomplished and dedicated surgeons in this community. He was inducted in the Marin Athletic Foundation

Hall of Fame for his dedication in serving the youth of Marin for so many years in this way.

The schools that offer these physicals are Tam HS, Drake, San Rafael HS, San Marin HS, Terra Linda HS and Novato HS.

Dr. Teasdale has been in solo practice in Greenbrae, California for the past thirty-two years. He is on the staff of Marin General Hospital as well as St. Francis Medical Center in San Francisco. Dr. Teasdale is very well known for his expertise in treating trauma cases at Marin General's Emergency Room.

Not every sports injury requires a trip to the Emergency Room, however, and he offers great advice on how to prevent injuries, what to do immediately following an injury, as well as treatment and expectations for recovering.
